convergent	plate boundaries that are coming together
divergent	plate boundaries that are moving apart
transform	plate boundaries that are sliding past each other
crust	the surface of the Earth

the middle layer of mantle the Earth made up of molten rock the inner, most dense part of the core Earth when larger rocks weathering get broken down into smaller pieces when pieces of rock get moved from one erosion location to another by wind and rain

deposition

when small pieces of rock get dropped off someplace else, like a body of water

sedimentary

rocks that are formed when small pieces get pressed together over time

igneous

rocks that are formed by melting and then cooling

metamorphic

rocks that are formed by heating and pressure over time
