You can read it with your parent or caregiver and you can read the newspaper or magazine in any language you choose!</p>	<p>No Internet Needed</p> <p>Read a book to your younger brother or sister, pet, parent, or stuffed animal. Don't forget to hold it up so they can see the pictures.</p> <p>You can read a book in any language you choose.</p>
