



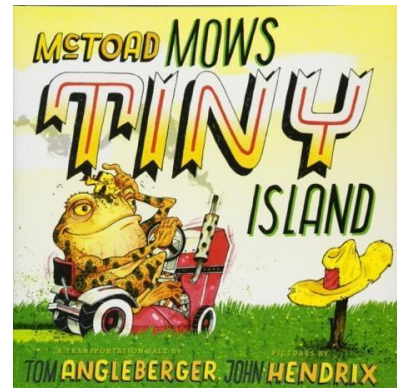
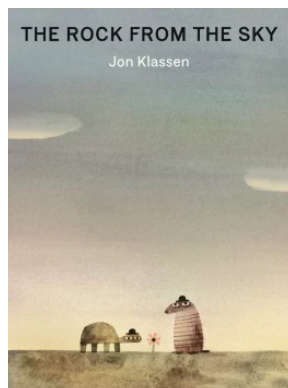
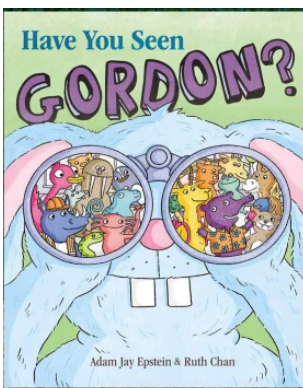
# Mrs. Markle's Summer Bookshelf

I love to start summer break with a trip to the library!

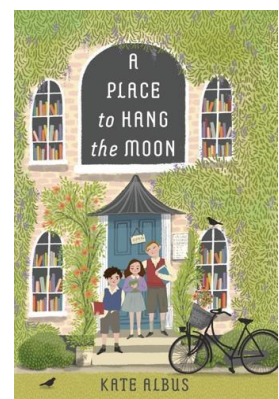
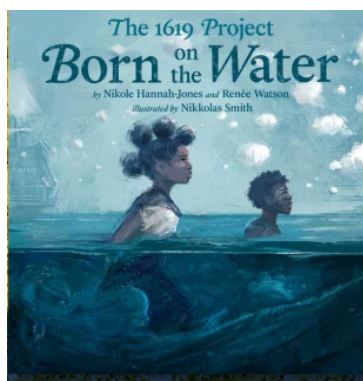
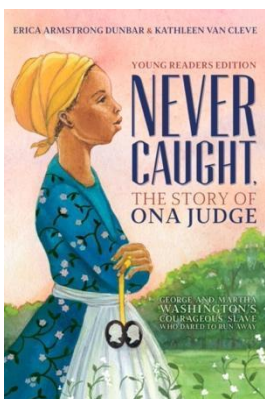
These are the books I have stacked up next to my favorite reading chair, ready to go for summer reading.
