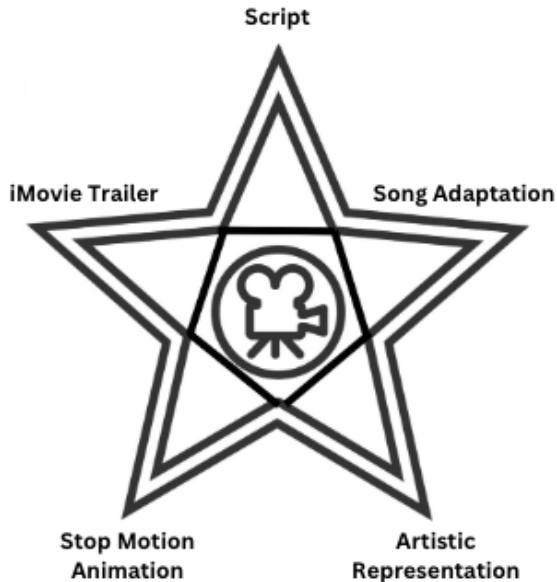

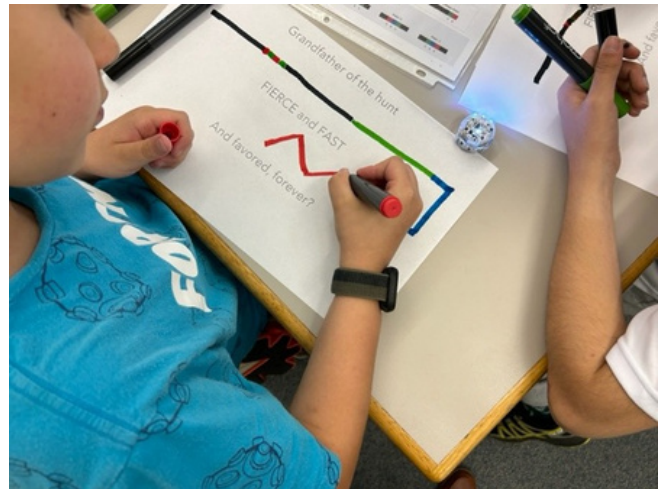


## LIGHTS, CAMERA, ACTION! 5TH GRADE

5th graders wrapped up their year in Language Arts with an open-ended, independent creative project. All 5th graders selected a unit, topic or text from this year's CKLA curriculum. After creating a storyboard to outline the important events or ideas in their selection, each student chose a film-industry inspired product to create. Some students tapped into their artistic ability and designed movie posters. Other students integrated technology and created iMovie trailers or Stop Motion Animated films.

## NATIONAL POETRY MONTH 3RD GRADE

3rd graders celebrated National Poetry Month in April with interactive poetry activities in the library. Poetry is great avenue for teaching critical and creative thinking. In one station, students created poems using paint chips by rearranging the chips to create spontaneous poems out of color names. They also color-coded animal poems for the Ozobot robot to follow. The color codes added sound, color and movement, so Ozobot animated the poem as it moved along the path.



## MARBLE CRASH TESTS 2ND GRADE

What better way to learn about measurement than by integrating real-world problems and ideas? 2nd graders learned about car safety and the use of crash tests during their measurement unit this quarter. Students conducted "marble crash tests" to observe how far their marbles would travel on impact. Data was collected by measuring distance traveled in inches and half inches.
